

Breaking Roulette Exercise from Harrah's Laughlin 000 5/17 – results in order left to right

Start with the dealer average of 0 so the Number €000 is listed as the target in the upper left corner for the target average and n/a in the upper left corner for the history distance. We can start with a dual sight adjustment and play €7MK II and €25 MK II with +1 adjustments. 24 chips total. The first result is the Number **€27**. The distance is +12. Remember , earning +\$24 chips to break even. Using that distance, we switch to MK VIII to play €1 MK VIII.

The second result is the Number **€1**, earning +\$19, with a +12 movement, and an average of 24/2 which rounds to +12. Since the average and history are equal, we will play consistent and play €3 MK VIII.

Third spin: the result is the Number **€24**, earning +\$1 with a history of -3 and average = 21/3 = +7. Following the history, we play €23 MK VIII.

The fourth spin result is the Number **€27**, with a history of -9 and average of 12/4 = +3. We earn +\$1 and continue on with the history and play €15 MK VIII.

The ball lands on the Number **€32**. Distance = -10, average 2/5 and earns +\$1. Since we are in a vulnerability, we use the history distance with the target's positive sight adjust and play €29 MK II and €26 MK II with +1 adjustments (24 chips total)

The next result lands on the Number **€34**, with a net loss of -\$6, distance = +8, average = 10/6. Since the distance target was successful, we use it to target the Number €23 and play €23 MK VIII.

The ball lands on the Number **€1**, earning +\$1, distance = +14, average = 24/7. We stay conservative and target the Number €7 and play €7 MK II with a negative sight adjustment on €20 MK II (24 chips).

The result of the spin is the Number **€28**, distance = +9, average = 33/8, and breaks even. Since we have a regular and positive average and history, we can play on the history and target the Number €15 and play €15 MK VIII.

The ball lands on the Number **€000**. We earn +\$1, distance +6, and average = +28/13. Distance +6 targets the Number €21 and play €21 MK VIII.

The next result lands on the Number **€0**, with distance -1 , average = +27/14, earning +\$1. Staying conservative, target the Number €26 and play €26 MK VIII.

The final spin of this exercise moves the ball -1 again and lands on the Number **€26**. Earns +\$19 with a final average of +26/15.

This exercise ends with a +\$60 profit. Make sure to use the 000 +1 adjustment and add or subtract +2 from the movements that pass over the Number €0. When the average and history are close together that can justify aggressive action, but as they move apart stay with the conservative patterns,
